How to Access Resources from CELA and use Dolphin Easy Reader

CELA (The Centre for Equitable Library Access), is Canada's most comprehensive accessible library service, providing books and other materials to Canadians with print and physical disabilities.

In order to create a CELA account, you will need a PUBLIC Library Card number e.g. GVPL or VIRL

For Teachers:

Teachers can sign up for an educator account. This will allow you to get access to resources to support your students with print disabilities. We do want to empower our learners to access this resource. You can support students with creating their own account (with their public library card).

Educator Signing up

1. Get a library card from a CELA Member Library. Ask your public library if they offer institutional or educator borrower cards.

- 4. (OPTIONAL) <u>Sign up for Open Book for Educators</u>, our newsletter to keep you informed about new books and technology for your students with print disabilities.

Eligibility

Access to CELA's collection is for people who cannot read ordinary print because of a visual, physical or learning disability as defined by Canadian copyright law. More information <u>about eligibility for CELA service</u> (opens in a new window).

If you provide an email address below, you will receive a user name and password so you will be able to download books on CELA's website.

You may also choose to have books or magazines delivered to you. If you want materials delivered, select the services you wish to receive.

Download books, magazines and other materials from the CELA website

- DAISY books and magazines download directly to player or mobile device. Both audio and accessible text are available. <u>About Direct to Player service</u> (opens in a new window)
- DAISY audio books and magazines on CD by mail
- Braille books by mail
- Printbraille (children's picture books with braille added) by mail

For immediate access click the two highlighted options.

For students who are visually impaired, CELA will create a copy of Braille books on parchment and send them for the student to keep.

Note: once you register for an account, it takes up to 5 business days for CELA to send you your username and password.

Step 2: Log into CELA from a computer, phone or chromebook, select the titles you would like to gain access to.

Formats for access through Dolphin Easy Reader:

DAISY text (Direct to player)

DAISY audio (Direct to player)

Step 3: Dolphin Easy Reader – to gain access to the CELA Material on iPads or iPhones or Androids



(I have had this added to the district's self-service app on SD62 iPads)

You will need to download Dolphin Easy Reader onto your iPad or phone to be able to access the "DAISY Direct to Player" downloads.

Alternatively, you can access other formats e.g. text and gain access from your computer or Chromebook.

- 1. Sign into Dolphin EasyReader using your gmail account (you can use your @sd62learns.org account).
